Conic Section. The conic sections are the nondegenerate curves generated by the intersections of a plane with one or two nappes of a cone. For a plane perpendicular to the axis of the cone, a circle is produced. A map projection is a systematic transformation of the latitudes and longitudes of locations from the surface of a sphere or an ellipsoid into locations on a plane. Maps cannot be created without map projections. Focus and directrix
The ellipse and the hyperbola are often defined using two points, each of which is called a focus. The combined distances from these foci is used to create an equation of the ellipse and hyperbola.
