

# Download Lake Burley Griffin Water Quality

Lake Burley Griffin is an artificial lake in the centre of Canberra, the capital of Australia. It was completed in 1963 after the Molonglo River—which ran between the city centre and Parliamentary Triangle—was dammed. Canberrans have been warned against having contact with Lake Burley Griffin after government testing found elevated levels of the dangerous blue green algae and other bacteria in the water.
