PE ratio is often referred to as the "multiple" because it demonstrates how much an investor is willing to pay for one dollar of earnings. PE Ratios are sometimes calculated using estimations of next year's earnings per share in the denominator. When this happens, it is usually noted. Microsoft PE ratio as of May 15, 2019 is 27.94 . Current and historical p/e ratio for Microsoft (MSFT) from 2006 to 2019. The price to earnings ratio is calculated by taking the latest closing price and dividing it by the most recent earnings per share (EPS) number.
