As a result of this disease is exophthalmos (protrusion of the eyeballs, or proptosis) as a result of swelling of tissue behind the eyeball, pushing it forward. Another symptom of hyperthyroidism is enlargement of thyroid gland called a Goiter. A goiter is inflammation of the thyroid gland, also known as the thyroid gland becoming enlarged. Worldwide, the most common cause of a goiter is due to a lack of iodine in our daily diet.
